

developing the things that matter to you and your child.



We do not wish parents to feel under pressure to provide a costume for your child, so we have decided to make this optional. Therefore, your child may


come to school dressed as a book character if they wish. Alternatively, your child can bring their favourite book into school to share with their friends.

The Narnia Experience




