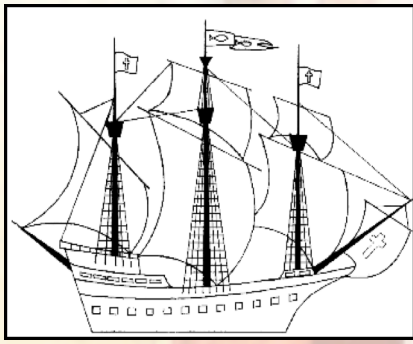
Our next meeting will be on Monday 8th May at the Anchor at **7.30pm**. Everyone is welcome. It would be lovely to see you there.

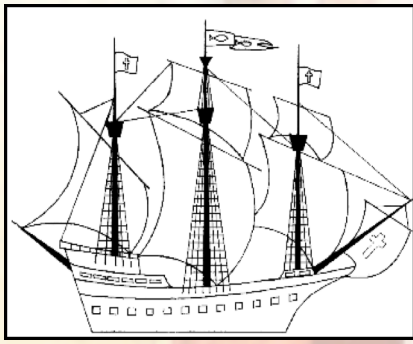
School Money

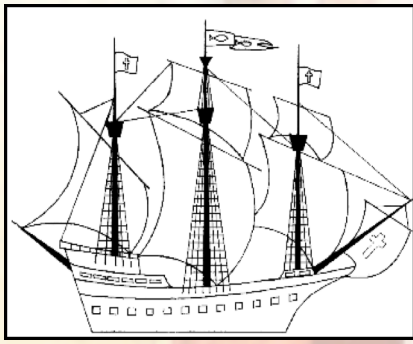

Parents' E-Safety Workshop

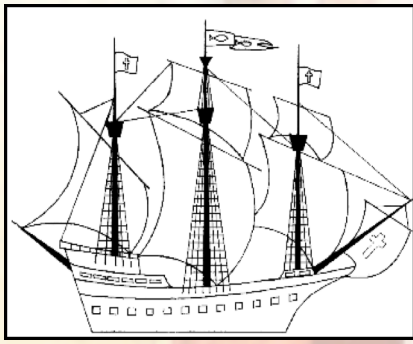
We are pleased to announce that we will be holding an E-Safety Workshop for parents of all year groups on **Monday 19th June at 6:00pm.**

This will also be an opportunity to see the photos taken during the Golden Jubilee Celebrations and to place orders should you wish to do so.

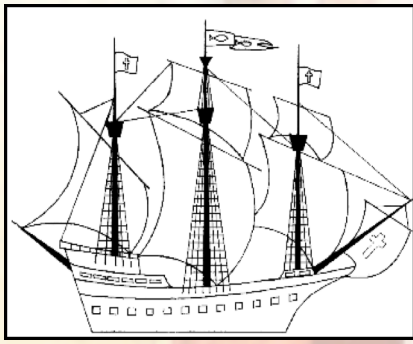

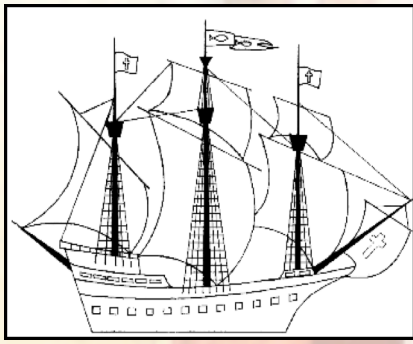


Fruit of the Spirit Awards Friday 5th May 2017
