Dear Parents,

Each week homework and support materials are set on Purplemash. The tasks are set to be available over two weeks so there is plenty of time to complete them. There is no expectation that your child completes every single task, but I would encourage you to look at the tasks with your child, especially the maths and English tasks as they offer valuable pre-learning for lessons we are completing in class.

Currently there are only 7 children, and sometimes less, that are completing tasks regularly. I understand that life is busy and there is no expectation to spend hours completing tasks, but even 15 minutes once a week could help your child to feel more confident approaching tasks in class or act as revision to consolidate learning. The children enjoy working on Purplemash in class and are quite independent when logging in and accessing work, as we use it every week.
