


The amount due until the end of the Summer term if you wish to pay in full is £79.20.

We were delighted to see yet more sunshine at our KS1 Sports Afternoon this week. Well done to all pupils who participated and thank you to the many family members who attended.




Y6 Residential to Barnstondale






