Shopping on Amazon

FoDS are registered on 'AmazonSmile' for charitable donations.

We are therefore asking all parents when shopping using Amazon on line to use smile.amazon.co.uk and select 'Friends of Dawpool School' as your charity (charity number 1094453) which will be remembered for future uses.

Additionally, Amazon Smile is now available for use in the regular Amazon shopping App. This may make it easier to use as you do not need to remember to go to the Smile website.

What is AmazonSmile?

How do I shop at AmazonSmile?

To shop at AmazonSmile simply go to smile.amazon.co.uk from the web browser on your computer or mobile device. You may also want to add a bookmark to make it even easier to return and start your shopping at AmazonSmile.

Which products on AmazonSmile are eligible for charitable donations?



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
Details about booking appointments will be sent home in due course.

School Curriculum



The <u>Curriculum</u> section of the school website has been updated to include additional information about our curriculum offer. There is a <u>Wisdom</u>, <u>Knowledge</u> and <u>Skills</u> document

School Lane Parking

Road Safety Officers have recommended the following procedure for people using vehicles on School Lane:

Park facing down School Lane

Vehicles should not attempt to turn around half way up School Lane. Car users are to proceed to the turning bay and turn their cars facing down School Lane before parking. This means that once the children have been dropped off or picked up, all cars should be able to leave School Lane without interfering with oncoming traffic. At no time should cars park on the zig-zag lines, across the school gates, use the car park entrance or Lane as a turning area.

The online application process for children who are due to start Year 7 in September 2023 is now open.


Children in Year 6 have brought home a leaflet to explain how to apply for a secondary school place. The deadline for applications is Monday 31st October 2022.

Flu Immunisation

As you may be aware, the NHS offers the free flu vaccine to all primary school pupils in years F2 to 6.

The flu vaccine is the best protection we have against this virus and has an excellent safety

record.

This vaccination will help to protect young people, their families and friends from flu at a time when COVID-19 is also likely to be circulating.

The vaccine will be given in school on Wednesday 19th October.

If you would like your child to have the free flu vaccine, please ensure you have given your consent by Monday 3rd October – this has been sent by email in the form of an NHS e-consent.

If you chose to take your child to the GP for a flu vaccination, please return the consent form confirming this.

Please note that the flu vaccination will not be administered in school unless the e-consent has been completed.

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
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Wirral Schools' Junior Choir
