

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to address a matter that affects the safety and wellbeing of our school community – parking outside the school premises on School Lane.

With school resuming after the Summer, we have seen an increase in the problems created by vehicles on School Lane. A major worry now is a steady upturn in the incidences of dangerous parking and manoeuvres carried out by drivers along School Lane during drop-off and pick-up times. We are particularly concerned about parking by the school gates, including outside Old School House, in a restricted area clearly demarcated with single yellow lines and zigzags. These actions place pupils and pedestrians at risk.

I would like to emphasise the importance of parking courteously and following all parking regulations when dropping off or picking up your children. By parking responsibly, you contribute to a safer environment for everyone at our school.

I have enclosed essential information for all drivers regarding School Lane. Please share this information with those responsible for your child's transportation to and from school.

Whenever feasible, kindly consider parking further away from School Lane and walking the remainder of the distance.
