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A reminder that the children must not bring mobile phones to the disco.


#### **FoDS Meeting**

Y6 pupils should receive the results of the 11+ examination by Monday 21<sup>st</sup> October. If your child has not reached the standard, parents should not give the grammar school as a preference as it will be withdrawn.

Parents will receive notification of their child's secondary school allocation on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2020.

Parents of children who have not reached the 11+ standard can submit a

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written appeal after **1st March 2020** if they wish to do so. Information about the appeals process will be sent to parents.
