

Wirral Lifelong Learning Service

Details of Lifelong Learning's new Family Learning offer are attached. The courses and workshops are completely FREE to all parents/carers.

Courses are designed to help parents and carers support their children with their learning and develop their own skills. Some courses are simply for the parents themselves, whilst others are designed so that the children join their parents in the second half of the session and the skills developed are applied. Courses take place in children's centres, schools, nurseries and community group venues throughout Wirral.

5 and 10-week courses are Accredited and Parents and Carers who successfully complete the course will receive an Ascentis Certificate.

Term Dates

Statutory Assessments 2023

Whilst all schools are required to deliver a range of statutory assessments each year, Dawpool's priority is to ensure that they are always administered in such a way that the children are happy and at ease. In many cases, the children won't be aware that they are doing a test and will approach them as a part of their usual classroom activities.

The timetable for statutory assessments are as follows:

Year 1 Phonics

The Year 1 Phonics Check will take place during week commencing 12th June 2023. The Check is administered on a 1:1 basis with Miss Barron / Mrs Warwood and the children will be unaware it is a 'test'. The children will see it as part of their normal phonics activities. Phonics scores will be shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Year 2 SATS

The Year 2 SATs will take place any time during w/c 15th and 22nd May. These reading and maths activities are delivered informally in small groups with Mrs Young and other classroom staff who know the children well. Mrs Young will use these activities alongside all of your child's





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work throughout Year 2 to make a teacherassessed judgement of your child's attainment. The teacher-assessed judgement is shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Year 4 Multiplications Tables Check

The Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check will take place any time between 5th – 23rd June 2023. The Check is administered on a 1:1 basis with Mr Greenop or other classroom staff who know your child well. More information about the Multiplication Tables Check can be found on the DfE website here. The Multiplication Tables Check scores are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

Whilst the Year 6 SATs are more formal in their delivery, we always make sure they are delivered in the most appropriate way for each individual child to ensure they are happy and at ease during the assessments. The results of the Year 6 SATs are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Easter Service 2023 Wednesday 29th March, 2:15pm



Families of children in Years 2-6 are invited to join us for an Easter Service at St Chad's Church on **Wednesday 29th March at 2:15pm**. Pupils in Y2-6 will leave school after lunch to walk to church. The service is expected to last around 40-minutes and parents have the option of taking their child home after the service. More information will follow shortly.

Pupils in F1, F2 & Y1 will remain in school to take part in a Holy Week experience which will involve a carousel of activities throughout the school, including arts, crafts, storytelling and singing.
