

Direct Rainwater Intervention Project



Last year, the school supported The Direct Rainwater Intervention Project (DRIP) who works with communities in Uganda to supply the neediest families with rainwater tanks and equip them with the knowledge and tools to use them. The results are households who are able to grow their own produce and become self-sufficient. They've evidenced many selling excess produce families at market and using this money to improve their lives, such as sending their children to school. We asked each class in school to raise £60 to fund a water tank.

We are delighted to say that each class has now received a photograph and a written message from the family who have received the water tanks and GPS co-ordinates of the tank's exact location. It is wonderful to know that we have supported 8 families in this way. Thank you to DRIP for the wonderful work they do.
