

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Welcome to wraparound!

Wherever possible, we like to take advantage of our beautiful setting and use the outdoor spaces. If the weather is good, please drop off your child(ren) at the wooden gate to the playground. Please ensure that they are suitably equipped with a warm jacket if it is cold and a sun hat if it is warm. Should the children want or need a quiet space if they are tired, or cold, this will be made available. When collecting from after school club, please see a member of staff on the playground - if we are otherwise occupied, please call the number below.

In the event of very wet or cold weather please drop off and collect your child at the door by the school office - please ring the main bell. Please wait for a member of staff who will assist you as soon as possible.

We provide a wide range of activities including physical play (football, tennis etc and playing on the "trim trail" and field), art and craft activities, baking, construction, board and card games, role play, dressing up and much more! We also try to use the forest school area once a week.

If you have any comments, queries or suggestions about our clubs (snack suggestions, activities you would like to see....) please do not hesitate to speak to a member of staff. Equally if you have any worries please let us know as soon as possible.

If any information that we have about your family changes, e.g. changes in contact information, family circumstances, changes to your child's diet, dislikes, fears etc. please do let us know as soon as possible. This is really important as it helps us keep your children safe and happy,

Please do not park in the school car park when dropping off or collecting as staff members are likely to be driving in and out and this could endanger the children. Also please do not drop children off before 7.45 a.m. and ensure that they are collected promptly by 5.45 p.m. If you would prefer to drop them off later or collect them early this is absolutely fine.

If you or someone else is collecting the children on a day when they are booked into After School Club, and therefore they will not be attending, could you please let the office staff or class teacher know. It would be helpful if this could be in writing, either a handwritten note or email is fine. Outside office hours you can send a text message to the phone number below. If someone who does not usually collect will be picking them up, please let us know. If we do not have prior notice we may have to contact you to ensure the children's safety.

Finally, if you or anyone you know would be able to come to after school club one day and talk about your work or any other interesting subject we would love to hear from you!
