Parent Workshop Monday 22nd April 2024

A reminder that The Mental Health Support Team in schools (Wirral CYP Mental Health Service) are providing a 1-hour face to face workshop to support parents in understanding your child's behaviour. This will take place in school on **Monday 22nd April at 2:15pm.**

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The aims of the workshop are:

- To understand children's behaviour, triggers and what reinforces behaviour difficulties.
- To understand parent-child interactions / relationships to reduce the escalation of behavioural and emotional problems
- To increase parent confidence and learn ideas for managing difficult behaviours and keeping your child safe.

Statutory Assessments 2024

Whilst all schools are required to deliver a range of statutory assessments each year, Dawpool's priority is to ensure that they are always administered in such a way that the children are happy and at ease. In many cases, the children won't be aware that they are doing a test and will approach them as a part of their usual classroom activities.

The timetable for statutory assessments is as follows:

Year 1 Phonics

The Year 1 Phonics Check will take place during week commencing **10th June 2024**. The Check

is administered on a 1:1 basis with Mrs Ham, or another member of staff who knows your child well, and the children will be unaware it is a 'test'. The children will see it as part of their normal phonics activities. Phonics scores will be shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Year 2 SATS

Please note that Year 2 SATS ended last year and will not go ahead in 2023-24. As in other year groups, Mrs Young will assess your child's work throughout Year 2 to make a teacher-assessed judgement of your child's attainment. The teacher-assessed judgement is shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Year 4 Multiplications Tables Check

The Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check will take place any time between **3rd – 14th June 2024**. The Check is administered on a 1:1 basis with Mrs Broadbent or Mrs Hall, or another member of staff who knows your child well. More information about the Multiplication Tables Check can be found on the DfE website [here](https://www.gov.uk/guidance/multiplication-tables-check). The Multiplication Tables Check scores are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Year 6 SATs will take place on the following dates:

English Reading Paper

Wednesday 15th May

Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic)

Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)

Whilst the Year 6 SATs are more formal in their delivery, we always make sure they are delivered in the most appropriate way for each individual child to ensure they are happy and at ease during the assessments. The results of the Year 6 SATs are shared with parents at the end of the academic year.
