Easter Service 2025

Families of children in Years 2-6 are invited to join us for an Easter Service at St Chad's Church on **Wednesday 2nd April at 2:15pm**. Pupils in Y2-6 will leave school after lunch to walk to church. The service is expected to last around 40-minutes and parents have the option of taking their child home after the service. More information will follow shortly.

Pupils in F1, F2, & Y1 will remain in school to take part in a Holy Week experience which will involve a carousel of activities throughout the school, including arts, crafts, storytelling and singing.

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Arrivals and Departures to School

Please may we remind families of the arrivals and departures procedures.

Arrivals:

- The opening times for arriving in the school are **8.45am – 8.55am** each day.
- Please do not arrive before 8:45am.
- Children should not be left unsupervised on the school playground before 8.45am.
- F1 pupils are greeted by staff and enter into the gated F1 area.
- F2 families walk pupils to the F2 classroom door.
- Y1, Y2 and Y3 pupils pass through the wooden gate independently and make their way to their classrooms.
- Y4, Y5 and Y6 enter through the library doors independently.

Departures:

- F1 and F2 classes finish school at **3:25pm**. All other classes finish at **3:30pm**.
- All classes are escorted outside by a member of staff who will be on duty in the playground until 3.40pm.
- We ask parents not to allow younger siblings, or pupils who have been dismissed, to play on the trim trail on the large playground.

- Once everyone has been collected please make your way out of school so that any after school clubs can commence.
