Children's Safety

At the start and end of the school day, whilst adults are waiting to drop off or collect the children, we have observed younger siblings being allowed to play unsafely in the small playground, for

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example playing on the steps, climbing on tables and benches and swinging on the metal handrails and ropes (which are becoming damaged as a result). Please note this also applies to some of our pupils who are aware they are not allowed to play in these areas during the school day so we would request you follow the same guidelines once they are in your care. Please be vigilant to the safety of all children at the end of the school day. Thank you for your support.

11+ Assessment – September 2020

We wish to notify you in advance that the local authority has determined that, for testing in September 2020, the test provider for entry to Calday Grange Grammar School; West Kirby Grammar School for Girls; Wirral Grammar School for Boys and Wirral Grammar School for Girls will be **GL Assessment** (Not CEM as in previous years).

GL selective tests will assess the pupil's understanding and application of knowledge and skills taught in and up to the end of Year 5, in various contexts.

The tests will continue to look at verbal reasoning, non-verbal reasoning and mathematics.

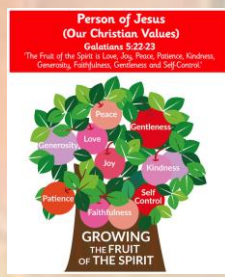
