

School Photographs Thursday 3rd October



As you may be aware, the NHS offers the free flu vaccine to all primary school pupils in years F2 to Y 6. The flu vaccine is the best protection we have against this virus and has an excellent safety record.

This vaccination will help to protect young people, their families and friends from flu at a time when COVID-19 is also likely to be circulating.

The vaccine will be given in school on **Thursday 28th** November.

Please note that the flu vaccination will not be administered to your child unless the consent has been completed. Further details about how to provide consent will be shared with parents shortly.
