Is my child too ill for school?

As we move into the season of winter illnesses, it can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school when they're unwell.

In the interests of promoting regular school attendance of pupils, the NHS have published helpful guidance on when to keep a child off school. Please go to:

If your child is too unwell to attend school, please phone the school absence line 0151 648 3412 (option 1) on the first morning of their absence, and provide a clear explanation of the nature of the illness.

Holidays in term time

Families should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid requesting leaves of absence for holidays.

As leave of absence is only granted in exceptional circumstances – **defined as** '*rare, short and unavoidable*' - it is unlikely that leave

of absence for a family holiday will be approved. To avoid mistakes being made with the school term dates, please check before booking – all school holidays until Summer 2025 are on the website <u>calendar</u>.
