Spiritual Expressions

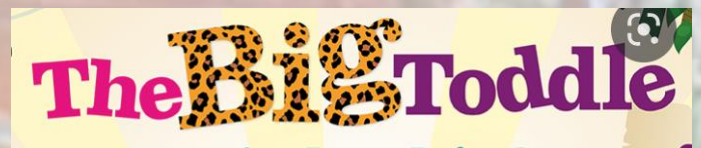
Year 5 pupils will be attending a special concert on the theme of Spirituality at the Floral Pavilion Theatre on **Monday 26th June**. They will join
