

European Elections 2019

Enforced Closure of Dawpool - Thursday 23rd May 2019

We wish to inform you at the earliest opportunity that the European Elections are scheduled to take place on **Thursday 23rd May** and the school building will be open to the general public for voting from 7am up to 10pm. When an election is taking place, we are asked by the Local Authority to accommodate the requirements of the *Representation of the People Act, 1983,* Chapter 2, Schedule 1, Part III, paragraph 22. This Act empowers the Returning Officer to make use of any school as a polling station. We are required to comply with this request.

In order to safeguard our pupils we have no choice but to close school on this day. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause, but we are sure you will understand that the reason for this closure is beyond our control.
