School Vision: The Dawpool community are united in their ambition to create a school which embodies the person, love and work of Jesus Christ: a school which enables Christian values to flourish and where all children may experience the abundant life that Jesus offers.

Schools are required to set 5 INSET days each academic year. There are two remaining INSET days this year on **Monday 22nd July and Tuesday 23rd July 2024**. Children will therefore finish for the summer holiday on **Friday 19th July 2024**.

We have now set all 5 INSET days for 2024-25:

- Monday 2nd September 2024
- Monday 6th January 2025
- Friday 2nd May 2025
- Monday 21st July 2025
- Tuesday 22nd July 2025

Please note that the INSET day on Friday 2nd May has been organised to coincide with the May Bank Holiday on Monday 5th May, creating a longer weekend for the benefit of families. The INSET days planned for July will mean that children finish for the summer holiday on Friday 18th July 2025.
