

## **Term Dates 2022-23**

All the school holidays, INSET days and bank holidays for 2024-25 are on the <u>Calendar</u> of the school website. Families should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission to take children out of school during term time. As schools should only grant leave of absence in exceptional circumstances, it is unlikely it will be granted for the purposes of a family holiday.

There will be five INSET days next year as follows:

- Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2024
- Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025
- Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2025
- Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025
- Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2025

Please note that the INSET day on **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> May** has been organised to coincide with the May Bank Holiday **on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May**, creating a longer weekend for the benefit of families. The INSET days planned for July will mean that children finish for the summer holiday on **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2025.** 

#### Uniform

Please be aware of the school's uniform policy for pupils returning in September.

# All year uniform options

- White shirt, either long or short sleeved, worn with a school tie
- Grey or navy trousers
- Navy skirt
- Navy pinafore
- Navy jumper, with or without the school logo
- Navy cardigan, with or without the school logo

#### PE Kits

During the first week at school in September, we will write to parents to let you know your child's PE day. Children may come to school on their PE day wearing their PE kit:

- Navy shorts or skorts
- White t-shirt (with or without school logo)
- Plain navy tracksuit (in colder weather)
- Trainers

# Bags and Belongings

The children may bring to school a navy-blue book bag, a small lunchbox and a water bottle, if required. We ask that the children do not bring larger bags or rucksacks as we are unable to store these.
