

#### **School Nurse**

The School Nurse will be available on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March between 2.30pm-4.30pm at the school for private appointments. If you would like to see her, please arrange this through the school office.

Alternatively, Wirral's 0-19 Health Service is offering weekly drop-in clinics for school aged children and their families.

The drop-in clinics are a safe and confidential environment to discuss

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health related topics including: healthy eating, weight management, sleep behaviour, bed wetting, behavioural concerns, emotional wellbeing, confidence/self-esteem and lifestyle advice, as well as signposting and referrals to other services if needed.
