#### Inter Faith Week 2024

This week, all children have been engaged in activities to celebrate Interfaith Week and learn about different religions as part of the RE and Diversity curriculum. The theme for this year's Interfaith Week is 'Stories with Meaning from World Faiths.' The week began with the children discussing their favourite stories and recognising the important messages they convey about positive behaviour, life values, and other topics such as good overcoming evil and the importance of friendship.

Throughout the week, we were fortunate to have visitors from various faiths share stories from their respective religions. Through these stories, the children learned that every faith has a rich tradition of meaningful stories that guide believers in their understanding of God and how to live a fulfilling life as follower of that faith.

Some of the faiths represented by our visitors included Christianity, Islam, and Hindu Dharma. As part of our Interfaith Week celebration, we also updated the window art displays in the

conservatory to feature the major religions of the world and their holy books. Each window is labelled with the name of the religion, the name of its holy book, and a story from that holy book. For example, the Hindu Dharma window showcases the story of Rama and Sita, while the Islam window features the stories of The Prophet & The Ants and The Crying Camel. Other displayed stories include The Story of Moses in Judaism, The Story of Siddhartha and the Swan and The Monkey King in Buddhism, and the story of The Milk & The Jasmine Flower and the story of Duni Chand & the Silver Needle in Sikhi.
