UNIFORM

We believe that there is a strong link between good behaviour and high standards of uniform and presentation. We encourage all pupils to take pride in

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their appearance and we ask that they wear the correct school uniform at all times. School shoes should be worn (not trainers). Hair accessories for girls should be discrete and match the uniform. Boys should not have designs shaved into their hair or dyed unnatural colours. A reminder that pupils should be healthy snack for provided with a playtimes such as fresh or dried fruit. Alternatively, pupils can pay for a slice of toast. Pupils should not consume crisps or sugary snacks during playtimes. Pupils will be reminded regularly of this instruction.

Toast Payments

Toast payments are now made online via Schoolmoney and those who are on our toast list will have received an email/text advising them payment is now due and should be made by Monday 9th September. Thank you.

Wraparound Care Payments/ Extra **Pre School sessions**

Payments for the above mentioned sessions paid online are via Schoolmoney. All sessions until 27th September have now been added and are to be paid by 11th September. An email/text advice has been sent so any new parents will receive the details of the website to log into and their password.

Lunchtime payments for Pre School

These sessions are also paid for via Schoolmoney but are not yet on the system. We are awaiting an update and once they are active you will receive an email/text advising you to go online and

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make the payment. We apologise for the delay with this and the deadline to make these payments will be extended accordingly.

School Dinners

The total payment due for School dinners for this half term is £81.40. With effect from this term payment should be made in full within the first 3 days of the start of term. On this occasion payment should be made by 11th September. As previously mentioned if you have difficulty either on a one off or regular basis paying in advance please let Mr Burrows know. Additionally if your child has a meal on a Friday, payment should be made by the previous Thursday evening. Thank you for your cooperation.

Leave of Absence Requests

Parents are discouraged from withdrawing their children from school in term time for family holidays. Head Teachers may only authorise holidays in term time in exceptional circumstances. Parents who believe their circumstances are exceptional are asked to complete an **Application for Leave of Absence form** which is available from the school office. This form should be returned to the school at least 2-weeks before the proposed leave. Parents who withdraw their child for unauthorised holidays in term time may be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice

Arrivals and Departures

The school opens at 8:45am each morning. The doors on the main playground will close at 8:55am. Children arriving after 8.55am must come into school via the front reception door and register with staff at the school office. Please note that pupils arriving in the classroom after 8:55am will receive a late mark.

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Our school policy is that pupils in Foundation Stage, Years 1, 2, 3 and 4 should not walk to or from school on their own or be left on their own on the school premises either before or after school. Pupils in these year groups must be collected at the end of the school day.

Parents of pupils in Years 5 and 6 may decide that their child can walk home alone. Your child will be prevented from doing so if permission has not been given in writing. A separate letter has been sent home to Year 5 and 6 parents with further information.
