We have sent home leaflets to parents with more information. Please note that the registration window closes on <u>31st May.</u> If parents are unable to register online, they can obtain paper forms by calling the Call Centre on 0151 666 4600.

Parents who do not wish their child to sit the 11+ examination do not need to register.
