### School Lane Parking

With school resuming after the Summer, we have seen an increase in the problems created by vehicles on School Lane. A major worry now is a steady upturn in the incidences of dangerous parking and manoeuvres carried out by drivers along School Lane during drop-off and pick-up times. We are particularly concerned about parking by the school gates, including outside Old School House, in a restricted area clearly demarcated with single yellow lines and zigzags. These actions place pupils and pedestrians at risk.
