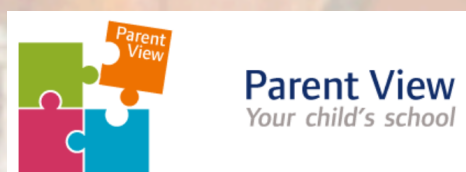

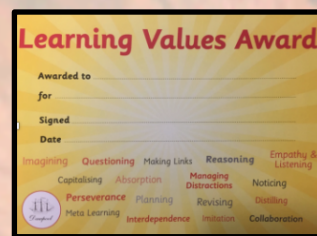
Y6 Visit to St Bartholomew's Church
